

44th Annual Seminar on Contemporary Music for the Young

March 31 - April 2, 2023

The Rivers School Conservatory's (RSC) Contemporary Seminar began in 1975 and has become the model for many such events throughout the United States and the world. It has featured collaborations with renowned composers including John Cage, Joan Tower, and Chen Yi. More than 3,000 works have been performed, representing nearly 2,000 composers and 720 premieres. Year after year, the seminar brings together a multigenerational audience of musicians, composers, educators, and music-lovers.

This year's seminar will feature award-winning composer and Berklee College of Music professor Andrew List. RSC faculty and student recitals, premieres of smaller commissions (including one by Rivers School alumna Apsi Balamurugan '20), and a roundtable discussion with panelists representing A Far Cry, Berklee College of Music, and Castle of our Skins will lead to the world premiere of List's commissioned work *The Dignified Heart for Piano Trio: A Tribute to Three Human Rights Leaders*.
