Description:

The RSC Videographer Intern will be using RSC equipment to record and live stream Friday recitals and periodic concerts during the weekends. The intern is also responsible for video editing and will be working closely with the Marketing & Communications Manager. Video recording and live stream equipment is provided by the RSC. The internship will last from September 23, 2022 - June 30, 2023 with the possibility of becoming a part-time position.

Job Duties:

- Simultaneously record Friday recitals while live streaming them on our Facebook
- Setting up and tearing down video/audio equipment
- Video editing of recorded content
- Lighting and sound for concerts
- Proficiency with overlaying text, closed captions, and graphics to edited videos

- Have 1 year of event recording and live streaming experience
- Must have a car and availability on Fridays and periodically during the weekends
- Ability to work on site at the RSC
- Proficiency in Adobe Premiere Pro or other equivalent softwares
- Proficiency with Adobe Creative Suite a plus

- Stellar communication and organization skills
- Can work independently and in a small team
- Enthusiasm and/or experience with working in a performing arts environment is a must
